Welcome and Housekeeping:

- 1. Chair Paige Dowling called the meeting to order and conducted a roll call of teleconference participants. Dowling determined a quorum was present.
- 2. Dowling reminded members of the ethics statement printed on the agenda.
- 3. Dowling reviewed the agenda and asked if there were any modifications. Debbie Coffey motioned to approve the agenda as presented; Randy Wiggins seconded the motion, and it was approved unanimously.
- 4. Dowling offered the opportunity for public comment; no members of the public were present.

Action Items:

- Rose Bauguess presented the minutes from the January 15, 2020 SWRPO TCC meeting for review and discussion. Michael Poston motioned to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Wiggins; the motion passed unanimously.
- 6. Bauguess presented the FY 2021 SWRPO Planning Work Program. Wiggins motioned to approve the amendment, seconded by Poston; the motion passed unanimously.
- 7. Bauguess presented a resolution in support of the Town of Hayesville's Bicycle and Pedestrian Planning Grant Application. Coffey motioned to approve the resolution of support. Poston made a second and the motion passed unanimously.

Informational Items:

- 8. Bauguess provided the SWRPO Staff update, including:
 - The Macon County CTP is nearing completion of the draft recommendations and we are hoping to have public workshops this summer if possible. We will also develop on online survey.
 - NCDOT Bicycle and Pedestrian Planning Grant deadline has been extended to June 30.
 - NCDOT Great Trails State Plan is underway. A public input survey is open until September 30, 2020. A Division 14 stakeholder meeting will be held in June.
 - Our transit agencies have been hit hard by Covid-19, with ridership down over 85%. The CARES Act provided over \$322 Million for North Carolina. The initial round of funding will follow the traditional funding formula for 5311 funds. NCDOT has also provided an extension of unspent ROAP funds.
 - The Prioritization 6.0 Schedule has been changed again. July 31 is the new deadline for project submittals. SWRPO will need to add meetings in July to adopt our final list of project submittals.
 - The format for STIP projects numbers is changing for new projects added. Old STIP numbers will not change.

- 9. NCDOT's Brian Burch provided the Division 14 updates, including the status of the NCDOT funding crisis. Most contractors have been given the option to slow down projects and extend completion dates. They are currently below the cash floor and legally cannot enter into any contracts or supplemental agreements. The Division's 12-month let list only had two projects on it. Most projects in development are also suspended, other than the bond-funded projects. Bond sales are delayed. Blairsville Highway in Cherokee County, NC 107 in Jackson County, and Georgia Road in Franklin are all bond-funded for now, but if the bonds don't sell, they will also be suspended.
- 10. Roger Castillo provided the Transportation Planning Branch updates. The NC Moves 2050 Statewide Plan has an upcoming public comment period. He also provided a newsletter.
- 11. TCC Member updates:
 - Cherokee County wrote a letter of support for Corridor K. Trying to determine how pandemic is going to affect the county budget. Hopes Blairsville Highway project an continue with bond funding.
 - Jackson County is doing a Pedestrian Plan, had planning a survey to start in June.
 - Dillsboro has the bridge project going on and would like to see the project expedited.
 - Sylva is moving a crosswalk on Evalina St. They have had a slide on Allen Street. The road has fallen 34 inches, related to a slide on Chipper Curve.
 - Franklin is moving forward with their Comprehensive Plan. Public hearing is scheduled for June 1. Town recently approved CIP for existing sidewalks for future upgrades to bring existing sidewalks into compliance totals \$2.8 million if all were completed. Recenty had significant flooding and slides in town on Crawford Branch.
 - Highlands is starting a Comprehensive Plan; received nine proposals.
