Welcome and Housekeeping:

1. Vice-chair James Reid called the meeting to order and conducted roll call of video-conference participants. Reid determined a quorum was present.
2. Reid reminded members of the ethics statement printed on the agenda.
3. Reid asked if there were any modifications to the agenda. Hearing none, Lynda Sossamon motioned to approve the agenda as presented, with a second by Rick Ramsey. The agenda was approved unanimously.
4. Reid offered the opportunity for public comment; there were none.

Action Items:

5. Reid called for nominations for a new TAC Chair and Vice-Chair. Ronnie Beale nominated Patrick Taylor for Chair and Lynda Sossamon for Vice-Chair. No other nominations were made. Ronnie Beale made a motion to elect Patrick Taylor for Vice-Chair; Bob Scott seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. Rick Ramsey made a motion to elect Lynda Sossamon for Vice-Chair; Roger Parsons seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
6. Rose Bauguess presented the minutes from the September 16, 2020 SWRPO TAC meeting for review and discussion. Tracy Rodes motioned to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Patrick Taylor; the motion passed unanimously.

Informational Items:

7. Amna Cameron, the Deputy Director of Strategic Initiatives and Program Support at NCDOT, gave a guest presentation on the findings of the NC F1RST Commission (www.ncdot.gov/ncfirst).
8. Steve Williams provided the Division 14 updates. The Department is now well above the cash floor and more projects will be moving forward. Many dates have been moved farther out to balance funds. Projects that were considered “committed” will still be committed even if the dates have moved beyond the first five years of the STIP. All dates are subject to change.
9. Roger Castillo provided the Transportation Planning Division updates. We are working with the NCDOT Communications Office to develop a new format for the Macon County CTP. It consists of a brief summary report and refers to appendices for more detail. Roger also provided a newsletter that includes a link to a Pedestrian Safety Action Plan recently released by FHWA and the National Highway Safety Traffic Administration.
10. Rose Bauguess provided the SWRPO staff update. All TAC members need to complete ethics forms by April 15. The schedule for Prioritization 6.0 is still up in the

air. The quantitative scores will be released in July-August 2021 and at that time the Prioritization Workgroup will meet to decide when or if the local input windows will be opened. The next draft STIP would tentatively be released in August 2022.

The Southwestern Commission board meeting was scheduled to begin at 5:30, so the TAC member updates were skipped due to time constraints. The TAC meeting was adjourned at 5:25.

Macon County CTP

The Macon County Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) is nearing completion. The document has been updated to an updated visual format and is being prepared for adoption.

NCDOT Traffic Survey Group New Webpage

Traffic Survey Group has partnered with MS2 (<https://www.ms2soft.com>), a traffic monitoring software vendor, to provide our customers with access to the Traffic Count Database System (TCDS) webpage: <https://ncdot.ms2soft.com>. This resource web link is planned to be part of our existing Traffic Survey webpage: <https://connect.ncdot.gov/resources/State-Mapping/Pages/Traffic-Volume-Maps.aspx> in the near future.

This new resource will provide traffic data customers with direct access to a significant amount of data from our historical traffic data records while providing some new “bells and whistles”.

This webpage has raw data and processed AADT values along with many reports that can be generated to enhance customer usage of collected traffic data in our database. Collection station points can be viewed on a map along with a few other traffic data and NCDOT attributes.

The data availability still follows NCDOT long-standing practice of publishing traffic monitoring data only after NCDOT annual Highway Performance Monitoring System submittal in June and after all of the end-of-year processes are complete; currently 2019 and prior collection year data is available (and 2020 data will be published in summer 2021).

Western Highways to be resurfaced this Summer

N.C. Department of Transportation officials recently awarded three contracts to resurface highways in Cherokee, Jackson and Henderson counties. Sections of U.S. 74 in Jackson County, U.S. 25 in Henderson County, and U.S. 19/74/129 in Cherokee County are allowed to begin resurfacing as soon as April 15.
