Welcome and Housekeeping:

1. Chair Patrick Taylor called the meeting to order, and attendees introduced themselves. Taylor determined a quorum was present.
2. Taylor reminded members of the ethics statement printed on the agenda.
3. Taylor asked if there were any modifications to the agenda. Hearing none, Ronnie Beale motioned to approve the agenda as presented, with a second by Lynda Sossamon. The agenda was approved unanimously.
4. Taylor offered the opportunity for public comment. None were received.

Action Items:

5. Rose Bauguess presented the minutes from the March 22, 2021 SWRPO TAC meeting for review and discussion. Diana Simon motioned to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Tom Sutton; the motion passed unanimously.
6. Rose presented the FY 2022 SWRPO Planning Work Program for review and discussion. She reviewed the dollar amounts allocated to each program area. The total budget and the allocations are identical to the previous year's work program. Harry Baughn motioned to approve the PWP as presented, seconded by Tom Sutton; the motion passed unanimously.
7. Rose presented the SWRPO Prioritization 6.0 Local Input Point Methodology for review and discussion. The Methodology is nearly identical to the one used in Prioritization 5.0. The one difference is the provision for flexing up to 500 local input points between the Regional and Division funding tiers. If we decide to use this provision, we must notify NCDOT before submitting the Regional local input points. Lynda Sossamon made a motion to approve the Methodology as presented, seconded by Marcia Almond; the motion passed unanimously.
8. Rose presented the Macon County CTP and a Resolution to Endorse the Macon County CTP. The CTP has already been adopted by Macon County Commissioners and the

Franklin Town Council. The Town of Highlands is expected to adopt the CTP at their upcoming meeting. The RPO endorsement would be contingent on adoption by the Town of Highlands. Multiple public comments were received and reviewed by Macon County officials. The majority of them were opposed to the inclusion of the NC 28 modernization project from Sanderstown Rd. to Cowee. Ronnie Beale noted that local officials believe that NC 28 is an important route for the county and it is good to have it in the long-range plan. If it becomes a top priority for funding in the future, there will be plenty of opportunities for more public input and considerations for determining the scope of a future project. Patrick Taylor added that this plan identifies long-term needs, and most of these projects will not be built in the next 20 years, in which time Macon County will continue to grow. Ronnie Beale made a motion to endorse the Macon County CTP contingent on adoption by the Town of Highlands. Harry Baughn made a second and the motion passed unanimously.

Informational Items:

9. Steve Williams provided the Division 14 updates and news. The cash balance has improved significantly, so more projects are gradually being moved onto the Move Forward list. Projects with a let date before June 30, 2025 are included on the Move Forward list, meaning that they can be worked on. Projects with let dates after that date are not included on the list and are still on hold. As always, dates are very likely to change. There are also numerous resurfacing projects across the region getting ready for summer paving season. NCDOT expects to receive some of the federal stimulus money, but it has not been determined how much or how the funds will be spent. Drew Christy noted that the Governor's office is waiting on the state legislature to present their budget recommendations for the American Rescue Plan money that the state will receive.
10. Roger Castillo provided the Transportation Planning Division updates including a newsletter with several useful links.
11. Rose Bauguess noted that the NCDOT Bicycle and Pedestrian planning grants are due June 30.
12. TAC Member Updates were skipped due to time constraints.
13. Roger Parsons made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Ronnie Beale.
