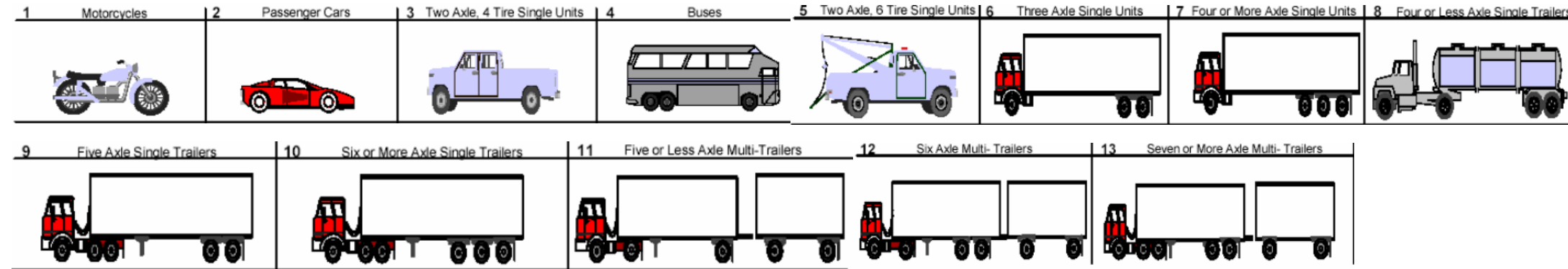


Macon County Comprehensive Transportation Plan – List of Maps from the Steering Committee Meetings

- Study Roads – The Study Roads Map highlights the major facilities that were analyzed during this study. These facilities often being roads with high volumes, important connectors, or being locally significant.
- Facility Types – This map shows the type of cross section that each road currently has. The map is helpful for identifying at which points the road’s cross section changes.
- Truck Traffic – This map shows the volume and percentage of truck traffic. Vehicles counted on this map include **FHWA Vehicle classifications 4-13 only.**



- Lane Width: This map shows the current lane width of each study road in feet.
- High Frequency Crash Locations – Displays the total number of crashes at each section and intersection between January 2014 and December 2018
- Fatal Crash Locations – Displays the number of crashes that included fatalities between January 2014 and December 2018
- Bridge Deficiencies Map – This map shows bridges that are either Functionally Obsolete (Built to standards not used today) or Structurally Deficient (Must be monitored, inspected and replaced at the appropriate time). This does NOT imply that it is likely to collapse or that it is unsafe.
- Environmental Features – A set of maps that highlights environmental features or potential impacts to be considered when proposing improvements or new facilities.
- Volume and Capacity Maps – A set of maps showing base year and future year traffic as well as the capacity of each road. Facilities depicted as overcapacity shows areas of congestion.
- Bike/Ped Crash Locations – Maps showing vehicle accidents involving cyclists or pedestrians.
- Bike/Ped Analysis – Shows DRAFT locations of destinations that people may frequent or would like to bike/walk to.
