

## PRIORITIZATION 5.0 LOCAL INPUT POINT ASSIGNMENTS: DIVISION NEEDS CATEGORY

Prioritization 5.0 is the process used to update NCDOT's State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for 2020-2029. The Statewide Mobility funds and the Regional Impact Funds have already been programmed. We are currently prioritizing projects for funding at the Division Needs category.

The Southwestern RPO has scored all of our projects according to the <u>Southwestern RPO Prioritization 5.0 Local Input Point Methodology</u>. The Methodology uses four criteria to score projects and determine which ones receive local input points. The two highest scoring projects in each of our six counties receive 100 local input points, accounting for 1200 of our **1300 total available points**. The final 100 points are designated for a non-highway project with local support.



Local input points are added to the quantitative score for each project, increasing the total score of the project. Projects are then sorted by total score and funded until the available money is programmed.

Approximately **\$160,000,000** is available in Division Needs funding for Division 14. Division 14 includes the 10 western-most counties of NC: Cherokee, Clay, Macon, Graham, Swain, Jackson, Haywood, Henderson, Transylvania, and Polk.

Projects eligible for Division Needs Local Input points include secondary road projects, non-highway projects, and any Statewide Mobility or Regional Impact projects that were not funded at a higher category. The Southwestern RPO did not have any projects funded in the Statewide Mobility category. We had **two projects funded** in the Regional Impact Category. These two projects were removed from the list prior to applying the Division Needs local methodology and assigning local input points.

#### R-5847 - US 64 from Hayesville to Peachtree in Clay County

- Right-of-Way 2024, Construction 2028 (Deliverable years, not subject to reprioritization)

#### R-5881 - US 64/NC 107 Cashiers Crossroads in Jackson County.

- Right-of-Way 2027, Construction 2029 (Developmental STIP, subject to reranking in P6.0)

The remaining projects that were scored for Division Needs points are shown on the following five pages. The local input point assignments are shown in the blue column. The projects selected for prioritization were all assigned the maximum of 100 points each. There were three deviations from the Local Methodology, which resulted from a discrepancy between the Local Priority criteria and the Quantitative Score criteria. If local input points are applied to a project with a low quantitative score, the project is not likely to be funded, so the local input points were moved to a project in the same county with a higher quantitative score.

The window for applying local input points at the Division Needs Category closes November 30, 2018. Total scores will be calculated, and the highest scoring projects will be programmed. The Draft STIP for 2020-2029 is anticipated in January 2019.

Therefore, the following deviations from the Methodology were used to move the local input points to projects with higher quantitative scores and better chances of funding.
